

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR GRASMERE CEMETERY

June 28, 2008

1. Plant row of trees along full length of Mill Road. Use sugar maples for historic continuity.
 - a. Eliminate (move some, if possible,) existing trees along Mill Road
 - b. Eliminate sections of range P on Mill Road (north) side of line P (dedicate additional cremation sites farther from road).
2. Provide for any additional mausoleums (max 6) by extending range lines A through E west to other side of Cemetery Road (in same way that lines were extended east into section 3 for existing mausoleums).
3. Plant double rows of trees around full length of Cemetery Road (see plan.*
4. Break up areas within sections 1,2 and 3 as shown in plan.*
5. Plant evergreen (moved from along Mill Road?) next to Mancini mausoleum on side towards Mill road.
6. Remove all Alberta pines and prohibit future planting (except flowers) at gravesites; encourage families to plant a tree instead (in prescribed locations) to memorialize loved ones.
7. Do no more clearing for future back extension of Cemetery Road until a master plan has been developed.
8. Move proposed section 3 east 3.5' to allow for easier planting along east side of Cemetery Road; shorten rows to maintain existing setback along western edge. (Note: it appears that this will not intrude upon existing mausoleums which sit back a minimum of 9.5' from pavement).
9. Work with neighbor across the street to fill in his missing sugar maples while we're planting.

* Species TBD. Locations shown are approximate; work with Gary to get exact locations to minimize maintenance and operational complications.
