

FACILITY RENTALS

Need a venue for a personal event? Residents are eligible to reserve Park areas and Pool Pavilions for private functions. Facility-use applications are available at the Town Hall and must be submitted no later than 2 weeks before your desired date of use. You will be required to pay the daily admission fee per party guest for pavilion reservations within the pool area. The pavilions located in the playground are free of charge, but not available during Summer Camp hours. Please check Rhinebeckrec.com or contact the recreation director, Alice Cunningham, at 845-943-9526 for availability.

REFUNDS

The Town of Rhinebeck does not issue refunds unless a program has been cancelled due to insufficient enrollment. Registrants assume full responsibility for any changes in their personal life, which may affect their ability to participate. In rare cases, a participant may encounter an unforeseeable and unavoidable situation that they feel may warrant a refund or fees paid. These situations will be reviewed on an individual basis by the Rhinebeck Town Board, who will then make a refund determination. A processing fee of \$25 will be retained by the Town in all cases that refunds, or partial refunds, are granted.

RETURNED CHECKS

The Town of Rhinebeck incurs additional administrative costs and bank fees when checks are returned due to insufficient funds. The fee for all returned checks is \$20.

SUMMER PROGRAMS

SWIM LESSONS



The American Red Cross Learn-to-Swim program is taught by certified Water Safety Instructors. Learn-to-Swim is a tiered program designed to provide students with a positive learning experience and teach children to swim and be safe in and around the water. Swim levels are established by the American Red Cross. Students will be evaluated on their first lesson to make certain they are in the appropriate level. Once all skills within a level are accomplished, children will be advanced.

Tiny Tots: A Parent-and-Me class for children 6 months to 3 years old to introduce them to the water.

Level 1: Introduction to Water Skills. This helps students feel comfortable in the water.

Level 2: Fundamental Aquatic Skills. This gives students success with fundamental skills.

Level 3: Stroke Development. This builds on skills from Level 2 by providing guided practice.

Level 4: Stroke Improvement. This develops confidence in the strokes learned and improves other aquatic skills.

Level 5: Stroke Refinement. This provides further coordination and refinement of strokes

Level 6: Refinement of Strokes. Improves stroke technique.
