

## **Marriage License Requirements**

Both members of the couple must be present at Town Hall. The cost is \$40 (we take cash or checks only).

Any person who has been married before must provide proof of the dissolution of all prior marriages (for example, if a marriage ended in divorce, a copy of a judgment or order of divorce is required; if a marriage ended in the death of a spouse, a death certificate is required).

The license is good for 60 days after issuance, but there is a 24-hour waiting period from issuance before it can be used.

The Rhinebeck Town Clerk's office is open to issue marriage licenses Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays from 9:00 am to 3:30 pm, Tuesdays and Thursdays from 1:00 pm to 3:30 pm. No appointment is necessary.

The following documents are required:

A person is required to establish proof of age and identity by submitting to the issuing clerk one of the following age related documents:

1. Birth Certificate (translated into English and certified if necessary)
2. Baptismal record
3. Naturalization record
4. Census record

And one of the following identity related documents:

1. Driver's license
2. Passport
3. Employment picture ID
4. Immigration record
