

## TO OBTAIN A MARRIAGE LICENCE IN THE TOWN OF RHINEBECK

The Rhinebeck Town Clerk's office is open to issue marriage licenses Mondays through Fridays from 9:00 am to 3:30 pm. No appointment is necessary. Both members of the couple must be present at Town Hall, 80 East Market Street. The cost is \$40 (we take cash or checks only).

Any person who has been married must provide proof of the dissolution of *all* prior marriages (usually by a divorce decree or a death certificate).

A person is required to establish proof of age with one of the following documents:

1. Birth Certificate
2. Baptismal record
3. Naturalization record
4. Census record

A person is also required to establish proof of identity with one of the following documents:

1. Driver's license
2. Passport
3. Employment picture ID
4. Immigration record

All documents not in English must be submitted with a certified translation.

The marriage license is good for 60 days after issuance, but *there is a 24-hour waiting period from issuance before it can be used.*
